“Lightning War” - German method of attack - fast movement of tanks (Panzers) and fighter planes

The German Air Force from 1935-1945

Blitz

Air raids on Britain by Luftwaffe, usually at night, during the Battle of Britain



Corvettes

Small warships, first used by Canada to protect convoys of ships carrying supplies to Britain during the Battle of the Atlantic



Bomber Command

Part of the RAF (Britain's Royal Air Force) responsible for strategic bombing of Germany (e.g. factories)
